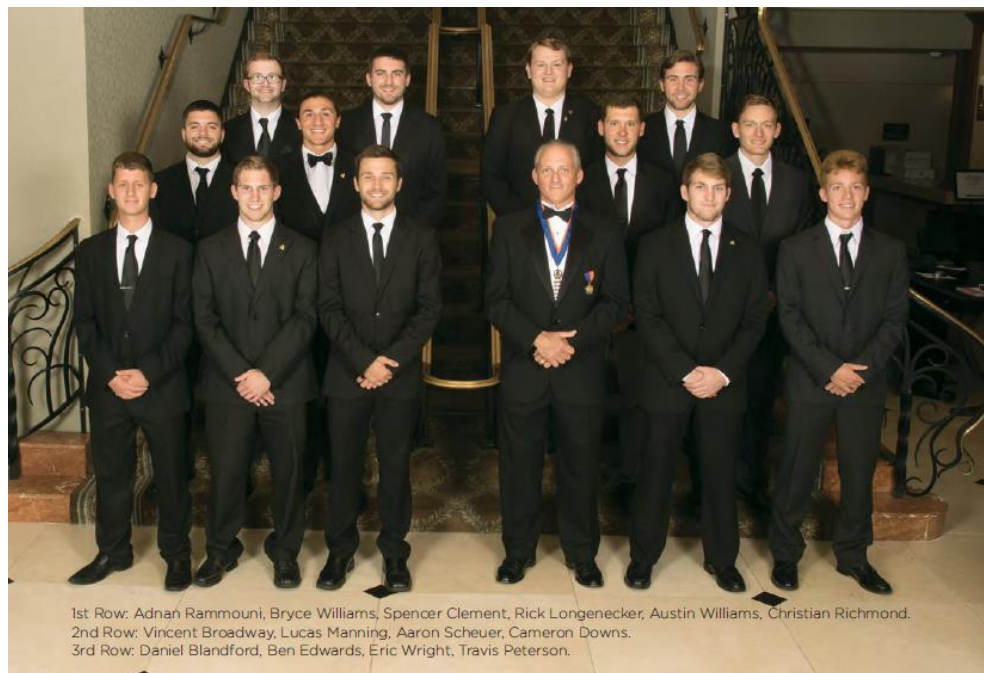

PI ALPHA WELCOMES 10 NEW MEMBERS TO JOIN THE BROTHERHOOD!

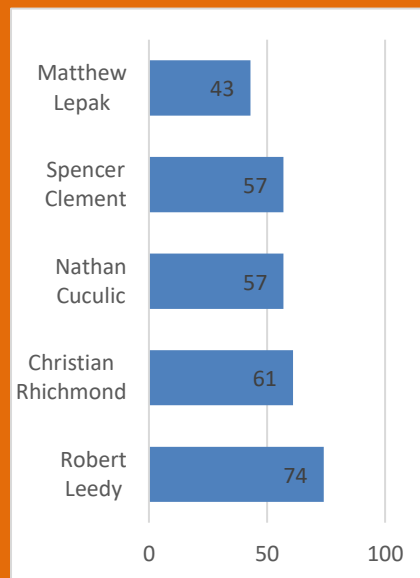
Pi Alpha's brothers worked tirelessly for the past month to prepare for a successful spring rush. 10 new members were welcomed on Sunday February 12.

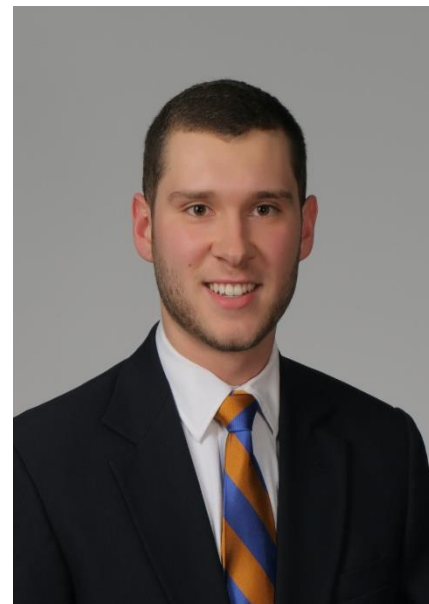


Pi Alpha is on the web
